Aim

Our aim is to create resilient learners who are able to adapt to their environment, seeing endless opportunities in all weather conditions.

We will continue to provide a service in all weather conditions unless said conditions pose a risk to the participants safety. If sessions have to be cancelled we will provide as much notice as possible depending on the forecast. All participants who booked onto the session will receive a credit to spend at a future session or a full refund.

Our top priority is to ensure the safety of all involved and therefore we cannot operate with wind gusts at 40mph and above and during thunderstorms.

Should the weather change whilst a session is in progress, we will blow a whistle to evacuate the site and the session will have to be terminated. Should this happen to families, they will receive a credit to attend another session.

We will continue sessions in any other weather condition.
